How can hospice care help?

The goal of hospice is to make you or your loved one as comfortable as possible during this time. It includes medical, emotional, and spiritual care.

Those who choose hospice care benefit from an experienced team that focuses on your unique needs, whether you're a patient or caregiver.

What can I expect with hospice care from VNS Health?

Our goal is to help you or your loved one make the most of every day.



Visits from a hospice nurse and other specialists, if needed. We tailor services to your needs. For example, if your team determines that you would benefit from the support of a physical therapist or dietitian, we will arrange the visit.



Home health aides to help with personal care.

Our home health aides are trained to give you or your loved one compassionate personal care, from support with bathing or eating to safely using the bathroom.



Medicines to manage symptoms.

Your care team will prescribe medicines to help relieve symptoms like pain, nausea, fatigue, and shortness of breath. And we'll deliver the medicines to your door.



Medical equipment, like a hospital bed or an oxygen tank.

Your team will order and set up any equipment needed to help keep you or your loved one comfortable. And we'll teach you how to use it safely.



Emotional support and spiritual care for both patients and caregivers. Your team will include social workers and spiritual care counselors who serve all denominations. They can guide you and your loved one through this difficult time.



Education and grief support for caregivers.

We will give you and your family the tools, education, and guidance to help you make informed decisions. We'll provide counseling and ongoing support during this time. And our program offers bereavement support for up to 13 months.

Who will be on my hospice care team?

As part of VNS Health Hospice Care, you will be assigned a dedicated team of experts, including:

- Doctors and nurses
- Home health aides
- Social workers
- Spiritual care counselors
- Bereavement support counselors
- Other specialists as needed, such as dietitians and physical or occupational therapists

Your team will work closely with you, your family, and your doctor to develop a plan of care specific to your needs. This includes details about the frequency of home visits from your team. They will also teach you about what to expect on the hospice journey.

You can access your team 24/7 through our support helpline!

Here are some signs that you or your loved one may be ready for hospice care:

- Frequent calls to the doctor or 911.
- Multiple visits to the hospital and/or emergency department.
- Treatments that aren't working or are no longer helpful.
- Multiple or complex conditions that may be getting worse.
- Difficulty doing day-to-day activities such as eating, dressing, and bathing.

Who pays for hospice care?

Medicare, Medicaid, the Veterans Benefits Administration, and most private insurance plans pay for hospice care.

We'll work with you to find out what's covered. And we'll help you get the care you need. Your VNS Health hospice liaison can also help you get answers to financial and other questions that come up.
